Once it was a merchant settlement, nowadays the tourist city is called a **Pearl of the Drawsko Lake District**. What attracts people to Czaplonek is not only the lake of Drawsko, but also the atmosphere of the city and the possibilities for opening themselves for interesting history. The city tempts with its well cared-for appearance, beaches which encourage to sunbathe, clean water which is ideal for practicing water sports, as well as undisturbed peace – sometimes broken by tuneless warbling of birds. Therefore, it is worth staying here for a bit longer. . .

People who visit Czaplonek have a wide range of attractions at their disposal and it is easy to choose something for oneself. There is an offer for active tourists and also for those who expect relaxation or peace and quiet.

Along with the growing popularity of water sports, in Czaplonek you can find **rental shops offering water sports equipment** as for instance sailing boats, kayaks, or pedalos. Those who are attraction-thirsty can go waterskiing or try windsurfing in care of professional instructors, and Drawsko Lake is excellent for the sports purposes.



Within the unique area there is one of the most beautiful **canoe water trails along the Drawa river named after Cardinal Karol Wojtyła**, who went canoeing here several times. Clean waters and diverse character of river sections are what makes it attractive.

Nature offers excellent terrains for hiking and cycling tourism. Landscape assets should be appreciated by enthusiasts of active recreation who like spending their time far from noise. The commune of Czaplonek is especially predisposed for cycling tourism. Biking fans have at their disposal **cycling routes** of diverse level of difficulty. All the routes run through the most attractive places in the commune of Czaplonek.

Charming nooks of Czaplonek encourage for walking along hiking routes, those for Nordic walking, as well as numerous nature trails. At the nearby former military airfield in Broczyna it is possible to land a light plane, a motor hang-glider, and alike. There is also a **track for cars and other off-road vehicles, as well as a shooting range**. Access roads are ideal places for rollerbladers, and the training yards are excellent for motorcyclists to practice the sport.

Not far from Czaplonek, at the **liwka motocross track** it is possible to check one's motorcycle and quad skills.

Landscapes of our region can also be admired from the height of a horse back, while going along **marked horse-riding routes**. Horse-riding centres offer not only horse-riding lessons but also field trips with an instructor.

For those who expect relaxation there are sunbathing and swimming attractions by over **40 charmingly situated lakes**.

For many tourists, one of the basic factors for choosing a holiday destination is a certainty of finding suitable accommodation at the spot. In terms of that, you will be surely satisfied, as Czaplonek offers a **wide range of choice of accommodation facilities** – from price-attractive camping sites to high-quality lodging houses and recreation centres.

What is also important during tourist trips is the **catering base**. Also at that point our commune is prepared perfectly for serving visitors at the highest level of quality. There are restaurants, pizzerias, and a wide range of places offering tasty food. Every guest who visits Czaplonek cannot leave the city without tasting the Drahim honey or the fish called vendace.

No matter where you come from, enchanted with the atmosphere of our Czaplonek land, its people or scenic landscape, you will always feel at home here. It is worth experiencing the feeling.

TOURIST ATTRACTIONS

Parish Church of the Holy Trinity – the church is the oldest brick building in Czaplínek, erected probably at the end of the 14th or the beginning of the 15th century. Originally, it had a tower, which was not reconstructed when the church was restored after the great fire in 1725. Inside there is a unique Baroque canopy altar. The church is situated in Moniuszki street, on a hill, where most probably there had been a wooden Templars' castle. Next to the church there is a wooden sawbuck-shaped belfry, which has bells from 1730, produced by bell-founders from Kołobrzeg.



Church of the Exaltation of the Holy Cross – the church was constructed within the period of 1829-1832 according to the design by Carl Friedrich Schinkel. It was built on a cross layout, in a style including neo-Romanesque and Classical features. It takes the whole eastern side of the central market square. Inside there is a neo-Gothic organ from 1862, wall polychromes from the period of 1954-1956, a ceramic mosaic from 1976, as well as wooden sculptures produced by Edward Szatkowski, a sculptor from Czaplínek, which decorate the side altar arranged on the occasion of the 700th anniversary of Czaplínek, which was celebrated in 1986.



Museum Chamber – the chamber was open in 1997. Among the huge number of exhibits collected here, the majority are household utensils, as for instance old charcoal irons, querns for grinding corn by hand, as well as strange implements for sometimes unknown nowadays purposes. In the hall of the chamber there are even several old farming machines. History enthusiasts will get interested with old maps and a collection of pre-war chronicles. A major part of the exhibits are objects donated by local inhabitants.

Open-space historic object – it is a collection of miniatures, which presents the most interesting historic objects of timber framing construction of the area of the lake district. In authentic surroundings of the historic object it is possible to admire the virtuosity of old constructors as well as of the present craftsmen. The open-space historic object also organizes thematic workshops, devoted for instance to handicraft, craftsmanship, or professions threatened with extinction. In the ART GALLERY it is possible to purchase original products of art. The venue is open every day from 10 a.m. until the last visitor.

Monument of Pope – the monument was created by Robert Sobociński, a sculptor from Poznań. It was founded with the means donated during collections and erected in 2005 directly by the waters of Drawsko lake, to commemorate priest Karol Wojtyła's stay in Czaplínek, the future Pope, who in 1955, together with a group of youth, took part in a canoeing rally along the Drava river, which started on Drawsko lake.



Ślawogród – is a modern reconstruction of a Medieval stronghold.

Fair reconstructions of historic buildings or fortifications impress imagination just like a gate of time. Having entered the gate, it is possible to move into the world of ancestors, where an adventure with the past starts. Ślawogród is not just an ordinary heritage park... The whole settlement is vibrant with life. Close to the palisade there is a livestock corral, by the cottage herbs are grown, which are used by the housewife for preparing decoctions and medicaments. The settlement is guarded by brave warriors, who resist attacks of barbarian neighbours and unfamiliar tribes. Women weave beautiful textiles with the use of looms, and there is a flurry of sparks raised by the blacksmith in his workshop! It is here where one can be trained to become a warrior.

The settlement is located in the northern part of the city, by the bifurcation of the roads no 163 and 171.

Ruins of Drahim castle in Stare Drawsko – these are relics of a fortified castle constructed within the period of 1360 – 1366 by the Johanniter Order, which was a seat of Drahim starosts within the period of 1407 – 1668. The castle was situated at a narrow pass between the lakes



Palace in Siemczyno – the palace was erected in 1722 by Henning Berndt von Goltz in Baroque style, together with a beautiful stylish park from the epoch, as well as a palace grange. Interiors were arranged in the Baroque convention. In 1796 the palace was extended. Throughout almost three hundred years of its history the palace changed its owners several times, and after World War II it was nationalized. Within the period of 1950-1986 there was a primary school functioning here. Since 1999 it has been a private property. At present in the palace there are: the unique in the whole province Interactive Museum of Baroque and the Uniwersalium of

Pottery smithy in Siemczyno – the smithy is situated in the locality of Siemczyno, within the area of the palace-and-grange complex, next to the fire station. In the smithy there are group an individual ceramic workshops organized. Each participant can learn the techniques of manual modelling, as well as using a potter's wheel. Pottery burning plein-air events are also organized here. Tel: +48 605 578 600



'Zapiecek' in Żeliszławie – Żeliszławie is a small village located several kilometres from Czaplínek. Here there is the seat of the Żeliszławie Association called 'Zapiecek', which for several years has been implementing a project for promoting traditional professions, as for instance, pottery, weaving, or baking traditional 'szczodraks'. During the tourist season there are educational events organized, when participants can produce a pot with their own hands, weave a rug, or bake 'szczodraks' (traditional breadrolls with cabbage). 'Tempelburg' Rock – the rock is located about 5 kilometres from Czaplínek, not far from the road running from Czaplínek to Stare Kaleńsko, near a small village of Cichorzecze. The granite relic of the grand glacial period from over a dozen

thousand years ago has a circumference of 19.5 metres and a height of 3.5 metres. For many years the rock had the function of a boundary stone, as there once was the border of the Drahim Starostwo. The name of 'Tempelburg' was given to the rock after World War II.

Water-mill in Głęboczek – the mill is the only water-mill located in the surroundings of Czaplínek. Such mills still existed in several places a hundred years ago and made it possible to local inhabitants to run their day-to-day life. In fact, the water-mill consists of a whole mill complex: the mill of a timber framing construction, a granary, and utility buildings constructed in 1898, when the bank of the Drawa river was reconstructed to make a properly high damming.



'Linolandia' ropes course – visitors have at their disposal three trails of diverse level of difficulty and height, from one to eleven metres. Each of the trails is a system of decks on various heights and rope obstacles installed on trees. There are a lot of interesting attractions waiting for the daring, as for instance Burmese rope bridges, vicious logs, meandering pales, artificial climbing walls, zip-line slides, and many others. In the ropes course everybody can have fun, from children over two, through teenagers, to adults. The system of the ropes course has been designed and arranged in such way that everybody, no matter how physically fit he or she is, is able to cover the whole trail, enjoying the extraordinary adventure.

Drawsko Lake – the reservoir is the best-known lake of the Drawsko Lake District, when seen from above, it looks like a star thrown on a pillow of dark velvet. And it is considered a star. It has charm, style, and potentials. Formally, its depth is 83 metres. Sailing round all of its fifteen bays can take even a week. On the way it is possible to moor at one of its twelve islands, as for instance the Bielawa island, which is the fifth largest inland island in Poland. The lake can enchant not only enthusiasts of water sports, also those who do not sail notice its beauty: the windless calm, billowed waves, sunrises and sunsets, water reflections of sunbeams, white sails, winter ice, feeding birds, or hunting sea eagles.



At the south-western bank of Drawsko Lake, in Drahimska street there is a sandy guarded beach. There are plenty of attractions for relaxing guests: a volleyball court, a badminton pitch, a water polo pitch, playground facilities, benches and tables. The beach is open in the summer season every day from 10 a.m. to 6 p.m.
